



# Medal Application

## LORD STRATHCONA MEDAL MEDAL

The Lord Strathcona Medal is one of the highest awards which can be bestowed upon a cadet/JCR. It is awarded annually to cadets/JCRs to recognize exemplary performance in physical training as well as their service, performance, example and excellence as a cadet.

The medal may be awarded only once to any one individual and awarding the medal is optional to the Commanding Officer. If no deserving cadet is identified the medal shall not be awarded.

### Selection Criteria

The recipient must have a comprehensive knowledge of the activities of the Cadet Program and must meet the following requirements:

- a. display a high level of physical fitness;
- b. have completed three years as a cadet;
- c. have completed all requirements of their squadron training program in the year of nomination; and
- d. be regarded by peers and supervisors as exemplifying the model cadet.

### Application Procedures

1. In order to ensure a fair selection process, cadets are required to submit the enclosed application form so that squadron staff are aware of all items applicable to the cadet's eligibility
2. Applications must be completed in full. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. Applicants must submit a narrative of 300 – 500 words which supports why they feel they are eligible and how they meet the selection criteria above. Narratives should follow the following criteria:
  - a. Uses a font of 12pt Times New Roman
  - b. Is free of grammar/spelling errors
  - c. Document is free of stains and wrinkles
4. Application and narrative must be submitted to the Training Officer no later than March 30.
5. Following the application deadline, squadron staff will review all submitted applications and make recommendations to the Commanding Officer.
6. Once the Commanding Officer has determined that a medal will be awarded to a cadet, the recommendation will be forwarded to the Sponsoring Committee.
